Why Register Online?

To register online, visit www.susumcamps.org and click on the camper registration link provided. You will be required to use a credit card to pay a deposit based on 50% of the Tier Two Price.

Paper registrations can be printed from the website and mailed along with a check or credit card information. They will be processed in the order in which they are received. Waitlists may be available if the camp is already full.

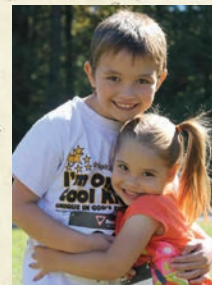

TIERED PRICING

At Susquehanna Conference United Methodist Camp and Retreat Ministry we believe summer camp is extremely valuable to the spiritual, mental, and physical growth of children and youth. Every day at camp, Christian community is experienced, relationships are built, faith commitments are made, and tomorrow's leaders are developed.

We are proud to say that all of our camp events are priced significantly under the industry average, and are comparable to other United Methodist camp programs.

Our Tiered Pricing is intended to represent the true costs related to the camp experience, and allow families to select the level of payment most appropriate for their financial circumstances.

Each family may freely choose to participate at the Tier 3, Tier 2, or Tier 1 level. Every child will receive the same camp experience regardless of the tier chosen.

How It Works:

TIER 3: By choosing Tier 3, you are ensuring that our camps will be here for future generations. This rate will allow us to further develop our staff and programming, and perform upgrades and maintenance to our facilities.

TIER 2: This is the true cost of providing a week of camp, including program costs, food, summer staff, and camp administration. If partial or full payment is coming through a church or agency, we encourage you to support the camping program by choosing Tier 2.

TIER 1: At this level, every camper's fee is partially subsidized by generous donations. If you are unable to pay at this rate, please contact the Camp and Retreat Ministry Office to apply for a scholarship.

PLEASE NOTE: The choice of tiers is entirely yours, and in no way influences your child's camp experience.
