

## AVAILABLE RESOURCES AT WESLEY FOREST

**Worship Areas:** (3 total) Outdoor chapels (along Weikert Run, near Dining Hall, at the end of the Lake, Prayer Labyrinth, Apostle Trail.

**Campfire areas:** (6 total) Behind White Pine and Hemlock Lodges, by Penns Creek Lodge, beside Picnic Pavilion, at the end of the Lake, along Lick Run stream on Wildcat Trail, at the Adirondack shelters.

**Picnic Tables:** at picnic pavilion, Registration Pavilion, in front of Dining Hall, beside lake, in picnic shed at Penn's Creek Lodge, along Lick Run stream, at Adirondacks, behind Hemlock Lodge.

**BBQ grills:** At Pavilion, at picnic shed at Penn's Creek Lodge.

**Activities for Everyone:** Hiking, outdoor court basketball, 4-square, sand volleyball, GaGa Pit, horseshoe and quoit pits, 9 hole disc golf course, sports and activity field, 20 Eno Hammocks for lounging (staff set up required), Lakeside fishing (personal equipment required unless Wesley Forest sponsored camp or event), Penns Creek fly fishing (license, trout stamp and personal equipment required) , ice fishing on Lake (personal gear required), ice skating (personal gear required), sledding/toboggan (one toboggan available).

**Staffed Activities:** Geo-caching (5 GPS Units), guided nature hike (tree ID, spring wildflowers), rainbow caterpillar hike, Huck Finn fishing, earth ball games, fire building, map and compass skills, knots for camping, star study, night hike, stream study, outdoor cooking, home in the woods program, Native American educational programs, stream stomp. Prior arrangements required.

**Challenge Course** Wesley Forest staff is trained to lead your group through our field games and extensive low ropes challenge course. Prior arrangements are required. Please contact the Wesley Forest office at 570-922-1348 for more information.

**Educational opportunities:** Tree ID/Leaf collecting, spring wildflower area, star gazing and star studies, fossil hunting, Pardee Lumber Company site, self lead nature trail (Sylvan Saunter), compass trail. Ask Wesley Forest staff for more information.

**Trails of particular interest (Trail Guides available):** Hike to Fossil Rock, hike to Chimney Rock, Weikert Run Bridges (swinging bridge and monkey bridge), Wildcat Trail (covered bridge and tram tie impressions, Big Island Trail (cable car bridge), hike to the Adirondack shelters. Trail maps available.

**Equipment of Interest:** Sound system in Dining Hall, Keyboards (Penns Creek, Dining Hall, White Pine Lodge), Indoor/Outdoor Movie Theater, NOOMA video library, Popcorn machine in Dining Hall, TV/VCR/DVD (Dining Hall and Penns Creek Lodge).

**Sports Equipment:** volleyball, basketball, bases, bats for soft-safe balls, ball pump, playground balls, soccer balls, frisbees, disc golf discs.

**Sumer Camp Programs:** Challenge Course, field games, swimming in the Lake, kayaks, canoes, paddleboats, rowboats, hiking, crafts, geocaching, slip n' slide, stream study, stream stomp, night hikes, star study, optional sleep outs (field, Adirondack shelters, home in the woods area along Lick Run stream, 2 Native American tipis), Earth Ball games, Huck Finn Fishing, Native American Lore, fire building, scavenger hunt and SO MUCH MORE!!!

**Staffed programming opportunities:** Guided nature hikes (tree ID, spring wildflowers) rainbow caterpillar hunt, Huck Finn fishing, earthball games, firebuilding, map & compass skills, knots for camping, star study, night hike, stream study, outdoor cooking.

**Off Site Activities:** Bald Eagle State Forest, Bike trails, Union County Sportsmen's Club wildlife zoo, Pardee Pond Trail, Penns Creek fly fishing only area and Trophy Trout area, multiple local antique stores, Verna's Fabric Shop, Lewisburg Farmers Market (Wednesday Only), hike to old railroad tunnel, Mifflinburg Buggy Museum, RB Winter State Park (27 miles), Penns Cave (30 miles) and many other attractions too numerous to mention.
